Protective Measures

Aquinas College recognizes all valid orders of protection including cease and desist, no-contact orders, personal protection, or similar lawful orders. If you have a valid order, please inform the Department of Campus Safety to receive appropriate services.

Resolution Through the College

College resolution provides a prompt, fair, and impartial investigation and resolution conducted by officials who receive annual training on issues related to domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, and stalking and how to conduct an investigation and hearing process that protects the safety of complainants and promotes accountability. Throughout the College resolution process, parties can be accompanied by an advisor of their choice, will receive simultaneous written notice of the outcome, have the right to appeal the outcome, and will be notified when the outcome becomes final.

Sanctions/Corrective Actions

If a respondent is found through a resolution process to be in violation, Aquinas College may impose sanctions/corrective actions. Sanctions may include formal reprimand, disciplinary probation, campus restrictions, no-contact order, suspension, or expulsion. For respondents
